READ BEFORE USE

Before using, first review any product's ingredients to see if you have a known allergy or sensitivity to any of the ingredients in the formulation. Do not use any product if allergic to any of the ingredients on the ingredient list or its components. Also review the directions for use and only utilize the products as directed.

If you have a question or concern about using a particular ingredient contained in a product or if you have rosacea or other skin hypersensitivity or are pregnant, nursing, or planning a pregnancy or have a medical condition that could make the use of any skin product problematic, you should consult your physician before using the product.

Patch Test Information: If you are generally sensitive to any applied product, we recommend that you perform a patch test at home. An at-home patch test is a valuable uncomplicated procedure that can inform you if your skin is negatively reactive to an applied topical compound. One does this by applying a dime-sized amount of any new product to the inside of the wrist or elbow area. Leave the product on the test area for 12 - 24 hours (overnight). Should irritation occur in that area from that product, rinse thoroughly with cool water and do not continue to use.

Always use a broad-spectrum sunscreen of SPF 30+ during daylight hours.

GENERAL PRODUCT APPLICATION TIPS

- Cleanse hands thoroughly before applying or utilizing any skincare product.
- It is best to use any product on slightly damp skin after cleansing the skin and patting it dry gently.
- Try to avoid directly touching the dispensing area of any cosmetic product.

PRODUCT STORAGE ADVICE

- It is advisable to keep all personal care products out of reach of children, including skincare and cosmetics.
- In general, to help protect the integrity of skincare products, do not expose them to extremes of hot or cold temperatures and store them in a dry place at a controlled room temperature (20–25°C/ 68–77°F) and away from areas of humidity and direct sunlight.

Always use a broad-spectrum sunscreen during daylight hours. The use of SPF 30+ sunscreen alone is not adequate by itself in protecting the skin but must be part of a comprehensive approach to avoid the premature aging (structural, textural, and pigmentary changes) induced by the sun as well as the more important cancerous changes induced by ultraviolet rays. Sunsafe behavior includes avoiding direct sun exposure between 9am - 3pm, always seeking shade, wearing sun protective clothing and full coverage hats, as well as using broad spectrum SPF 30+ on exposed areas and reapplying at least every 2 hours.
